There was strong interest in all four of the topic proposals, with a preference towards evening events, and mixed opinions on family discussion vs. guest speakers. To that end, we are going to open up the first discussion around housing on November 12th, 5pm-6pm in the Community Room.

For families who have participants enrolled in programming until 4:30pm, we will offer the option for them to remain on-site in the rec area with staff supervision from 4:30–6:00pm while parents attend the Roundtable. This option is not available for Flex participants whose day ends earlier.

This will likely be our only discussion at Franklin regarding housing for the year, to ensure that there is bandwidth to discuss the other three topics by Summer. If parents would like additional resources from Capstone staff or would like to form informal discussion networks around these topics, they are encouraged to do so. Guest speakers will be invited to future events, as necessary.
