The following characteristics describe our campers:

- Verbal, using complete and fluid sentence structure
- Capable of learning
- Independently mobile
- Can function well with a 1:6 (middle/high school) or a 1:4 (elementary) staff to student ratio
- Perform all of their own personal care
- Behave in a way that allows for their own learning and their peers to progress
- Have a primary diagnosis that precludes any mental or behavioral disorder

Transportation will be provided to Hennepin Tech and students will be supported by a Franklin Capstone staff member in the classroom. Upon completion, students will earn one credit at HTC.
